



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **As a way to check in, share a quick story or memory related to a roller coaster or an amusement park ride.**
- **We talked about “liminal space” as this in-between kind of time where you are waiting for what’s next. Where in your life are you feeling like you can relate to being in liminal space? It might be a longer transition time, or even something smaller. What uncertainties are you feeling in this liminal space?**
- **Read together Mark 16:1-8. Name a way that you can relate to the women in the passage. Imagine yourself in the scene...what would you have said or done?**
- **Verse 7 says “Go, tell...” In the face of your current uncertainty, what is the smallest, most concrete "Go, tell" action you believe God is inviting you to take right now, even without having the full picture?**
- **The Gospel of Mark was written with a sense of urgency. The writer wants the reader to respond. As you think about the invitation to tell your story, where are you feeling an urgency? Where are you having resistance to urgency? Share where either of those responses might be stemming from in you.**
- **We talked about how only you can tell your story. Thinking about the last year (or month or week), identify a time where you experienced the risen Jesus. In other words, how did God show up for you or when did you feel empowered by Jesus. Who in your life might be encouraged if you shared that story with them?**
- **In this season of your life, what do you imagine it looks like to fulfill your potential and make an impact? How can telling your unique story be a step toward reaching your potential?**
